Travelogue Ireland

Places visited: Dublin, Belfast, Derry

Andrea Saemann writes:

The visit took place before any Brexit agreement. Linking up Dublin and Belfast by train, meeting artists from both places, made us aware of the two very different systems. In the midst of these differences the artist union succeeded to unit both sides, and works for northern and southern Ireland alike. The Republic contained within itself. Northern Ireland depending on a central government in London that at the moment has not installed any functioning local governmental offices on the island. Therefore, people develop the ability to take on self-responsibility for changes needed and initiate tools for collective actions. The artist run organization for Live Art in Belfast – **Bbeyond** – has developed and performs gatherings since 2002 as well as improvisational practices with its **Performance Monthlys**.

Nigel Rolfe, born on the Isle of Whight and Alastair MacLennan from Scotland, both made Ireland the centre of their activity. Rolfe in the South, in Dublin and MacLennan in the North, in Belfast. Rolfe taught at the Royal Academy in London, MacLennan at the University of Ulster in Belfast, where he became a founding member of Bbeyond. They are the most referred to people, when we address Live Art, along with Áine Philips from Galway, who edited «Performance Art in Ireland: A History», a possible overview of Performance Art in Ireland, published by LADA – Live Art Development Agency London in 2015. During our stay, Sandra Johnston was about to finish the first monographic book on Alastair MacLennan, which should appear by the end of 2019. She and Brian Patterson from Bbeyond were the ones, who linked us up with possible interview partners and took care of us during our stay in a very generous way.
